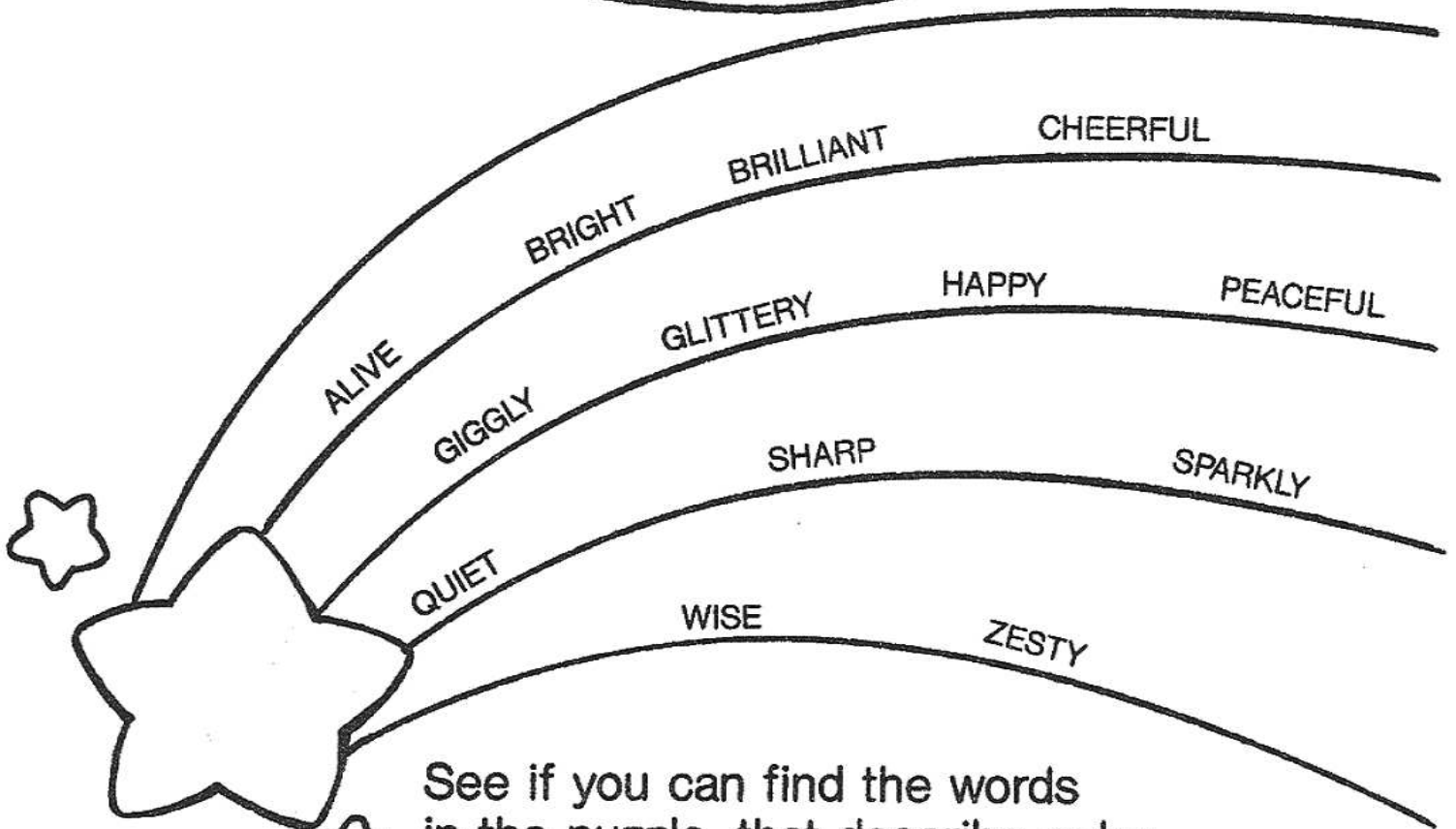
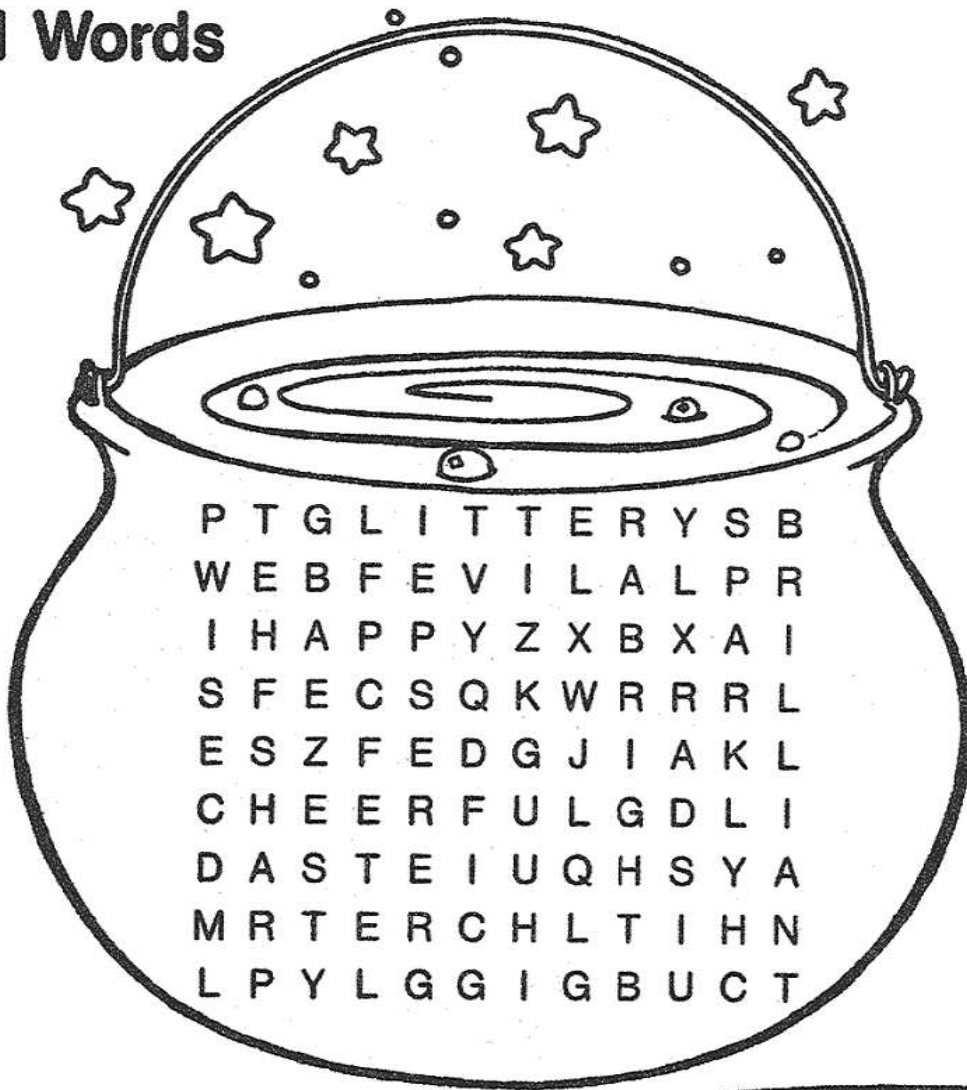




Kitty Brite is looking for one of the Color Kids. Her name is the same as a flower. Only one correct path will spell out her name.

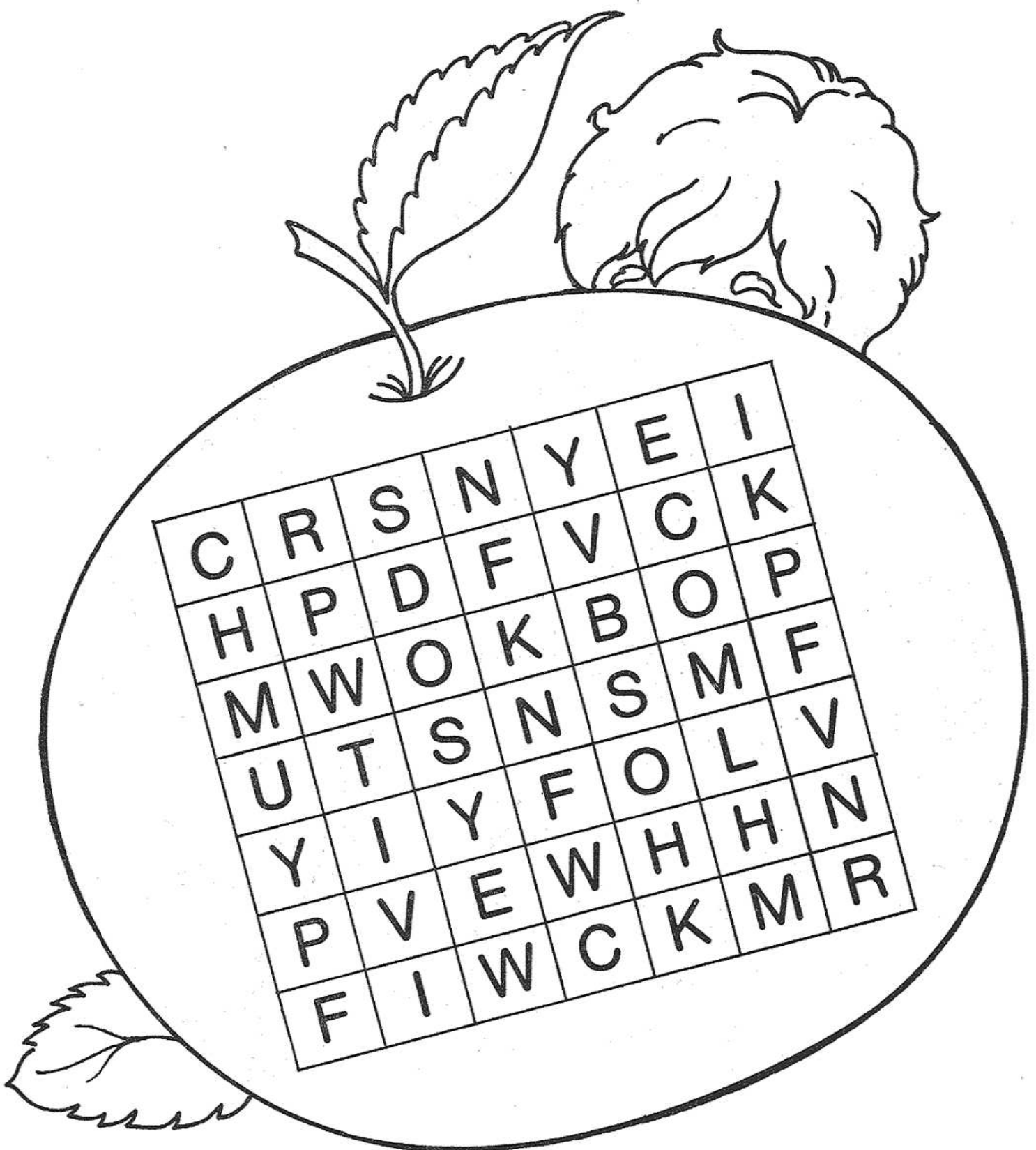


See if you can find the words in the puzzle that describe color.

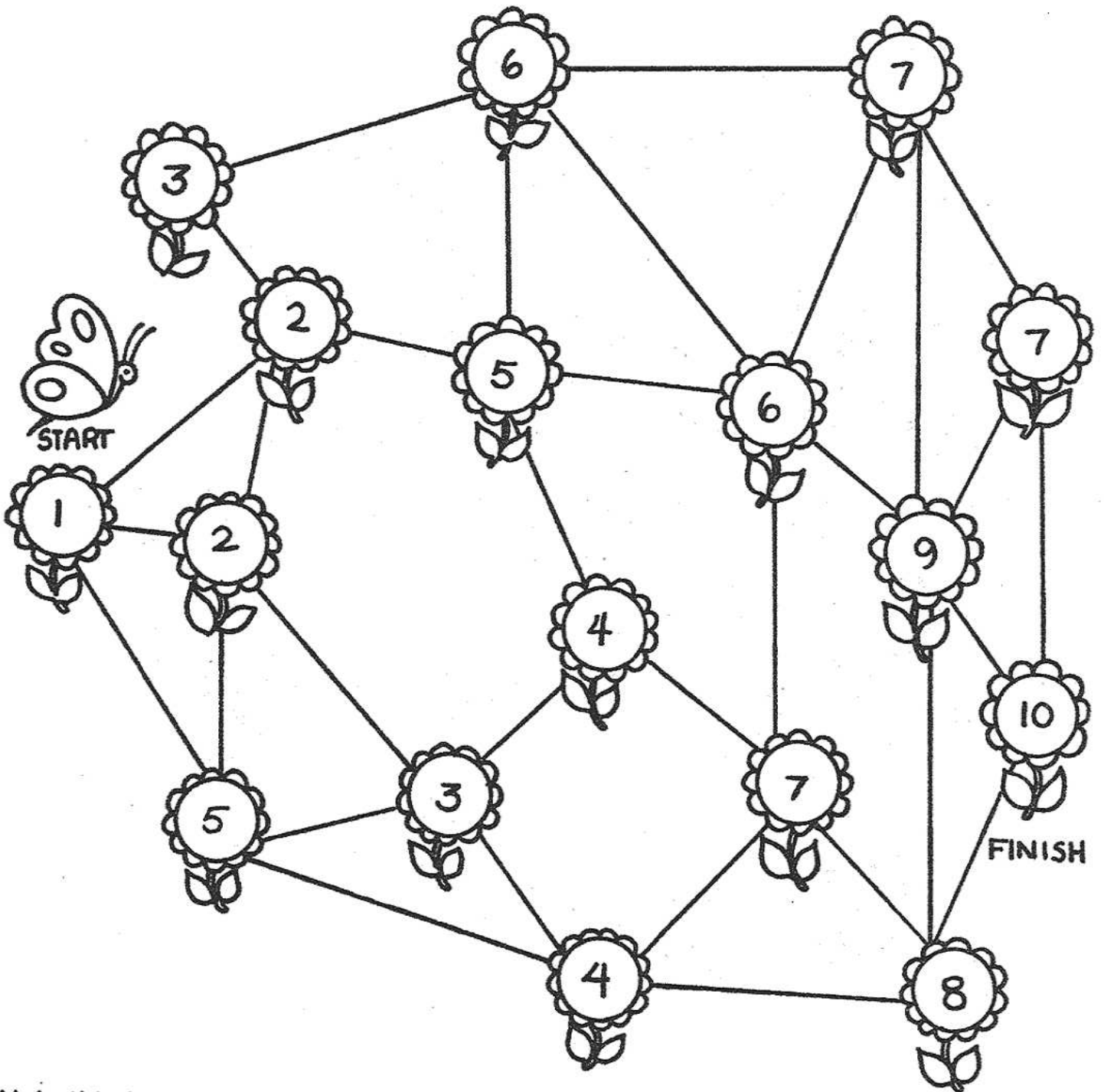

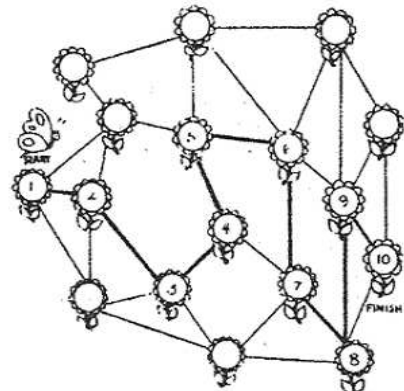
Butterfly Maze

Kitty Brite has a new wandering friend. Find the path that leads the butterfly from one to ten. It must pass over each number in order.





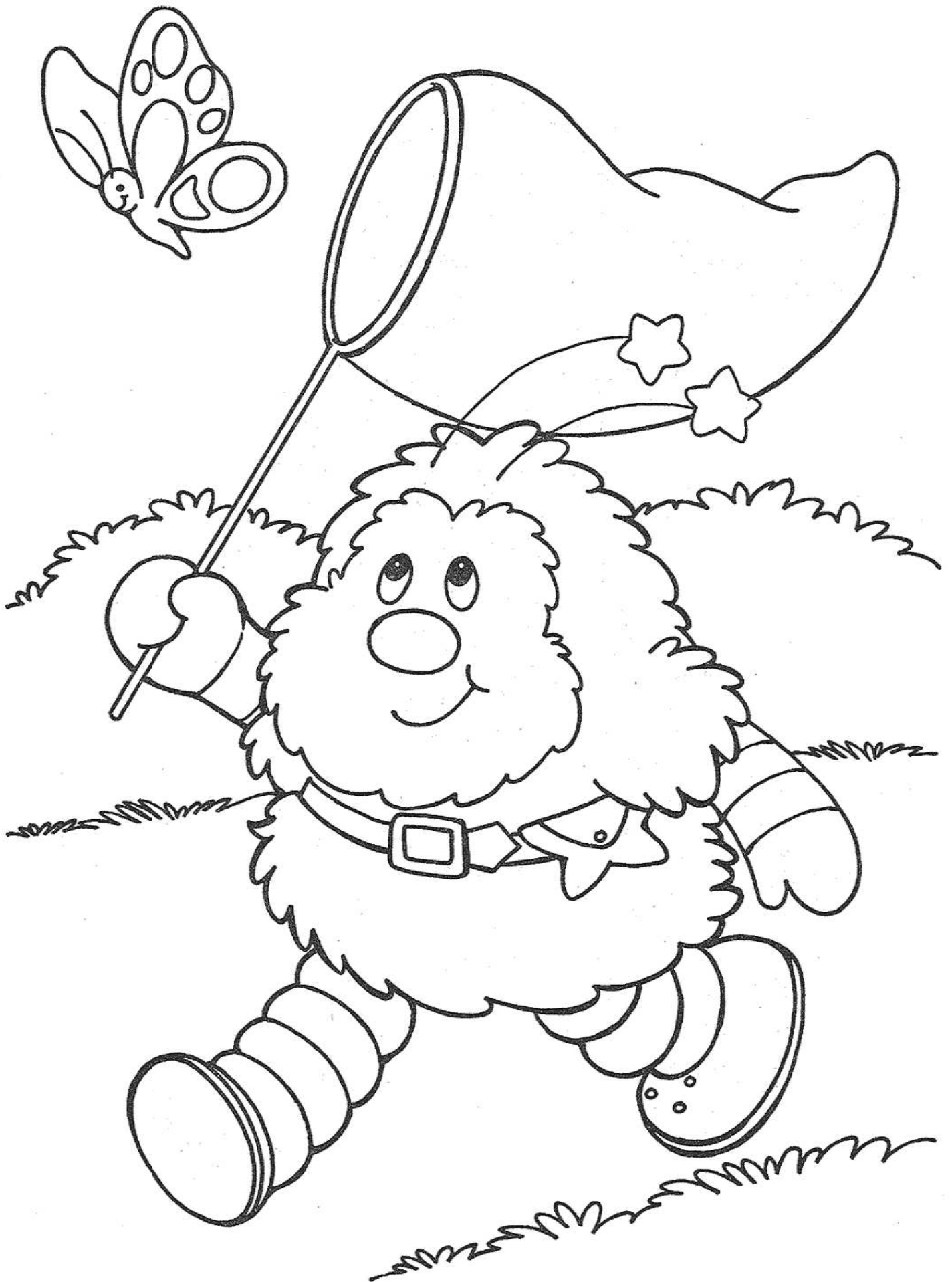



(A Game for Two)

Players continue playing until all the crystals are gone. The player with the most crystals is the winner.



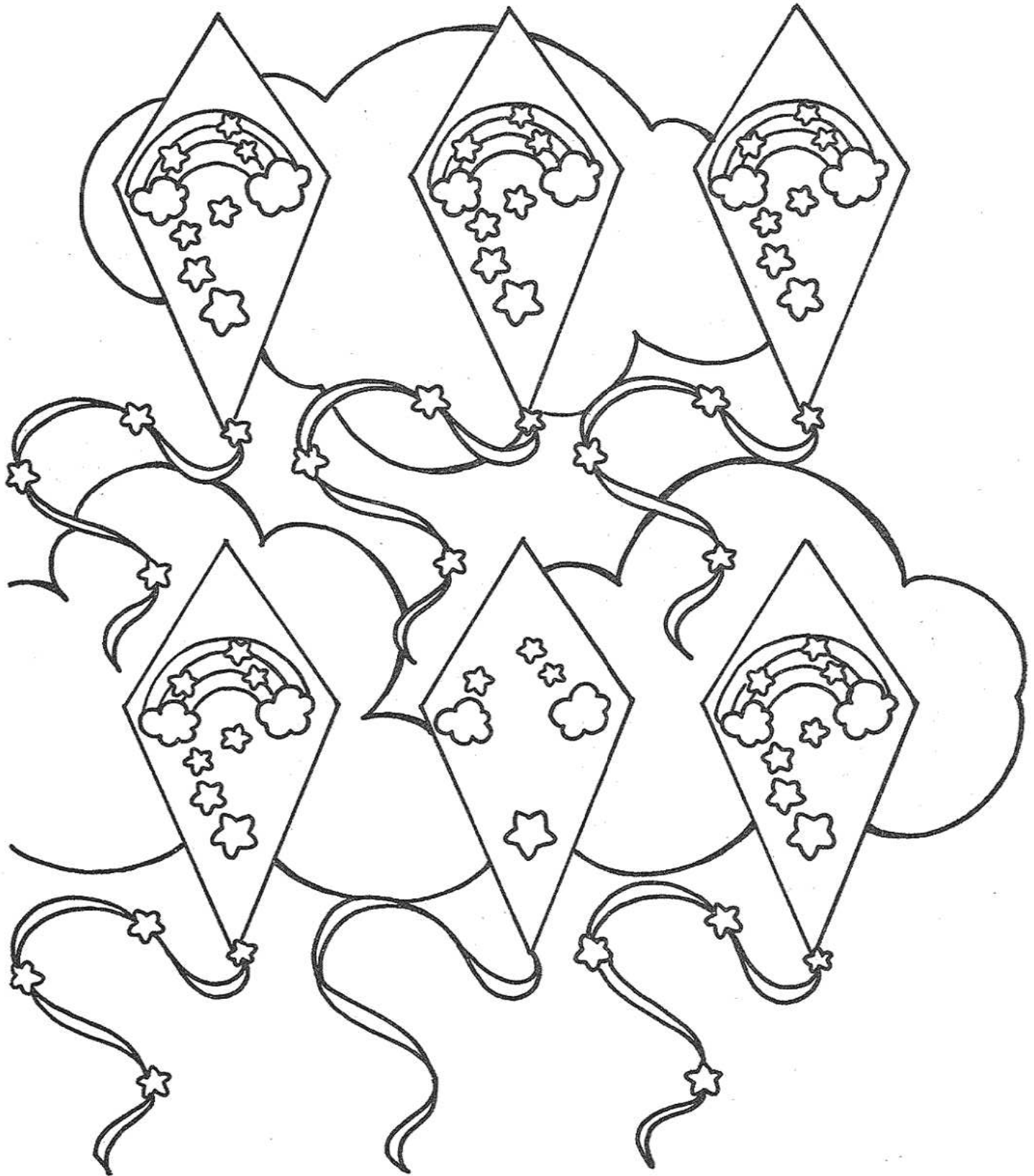


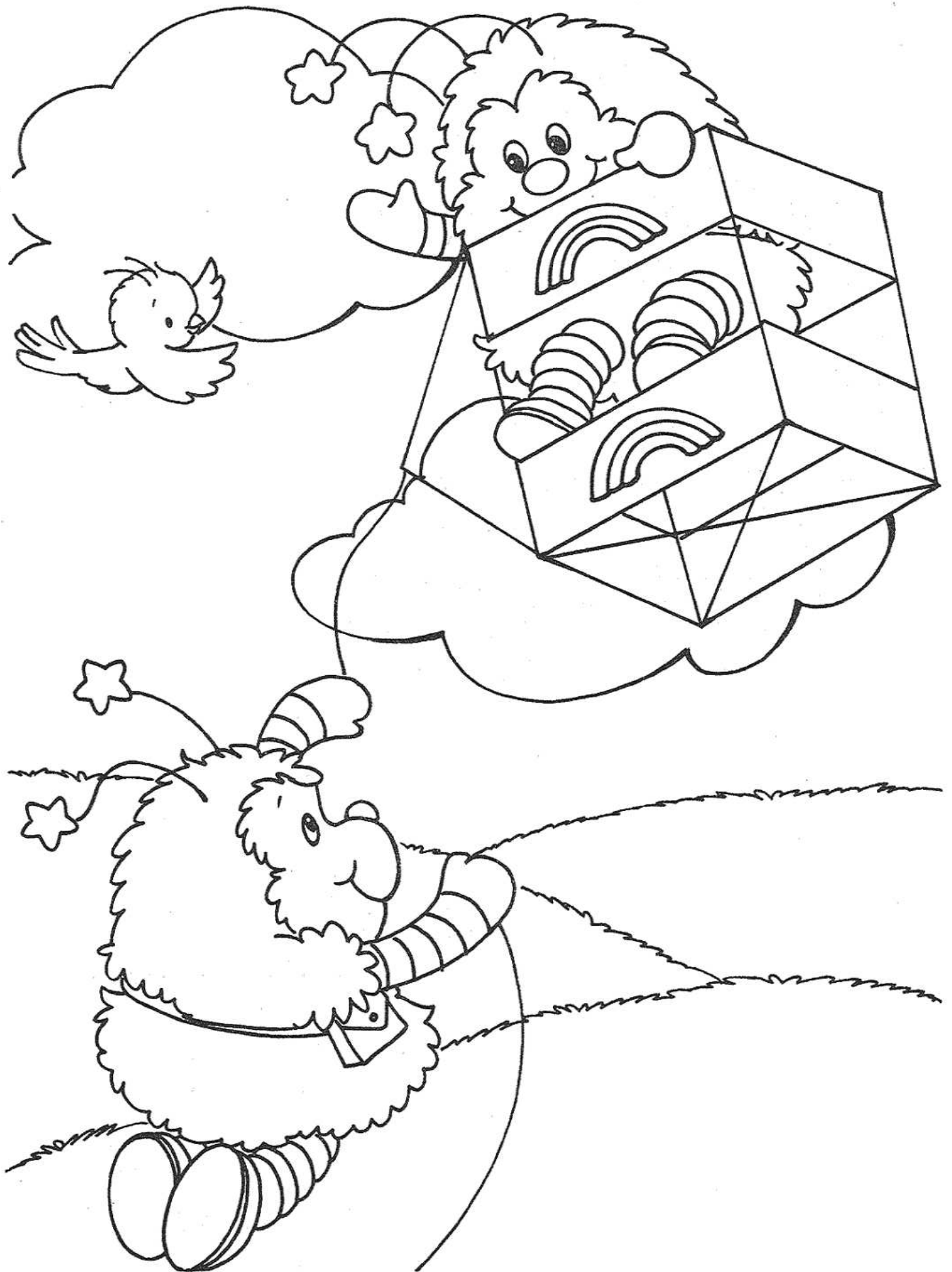

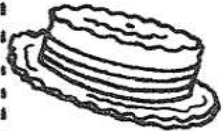
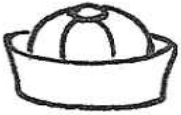
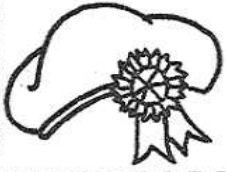




Hat Full of Sprites

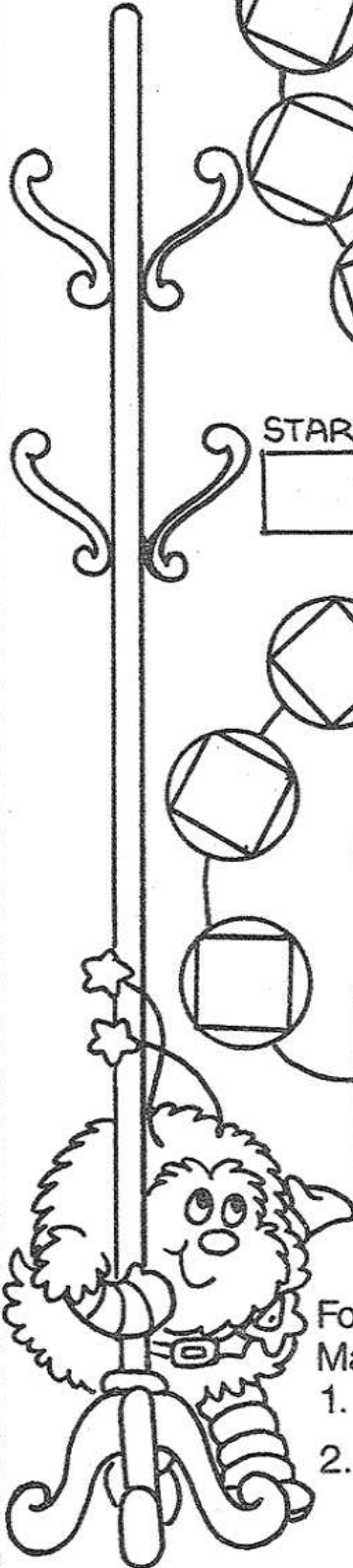

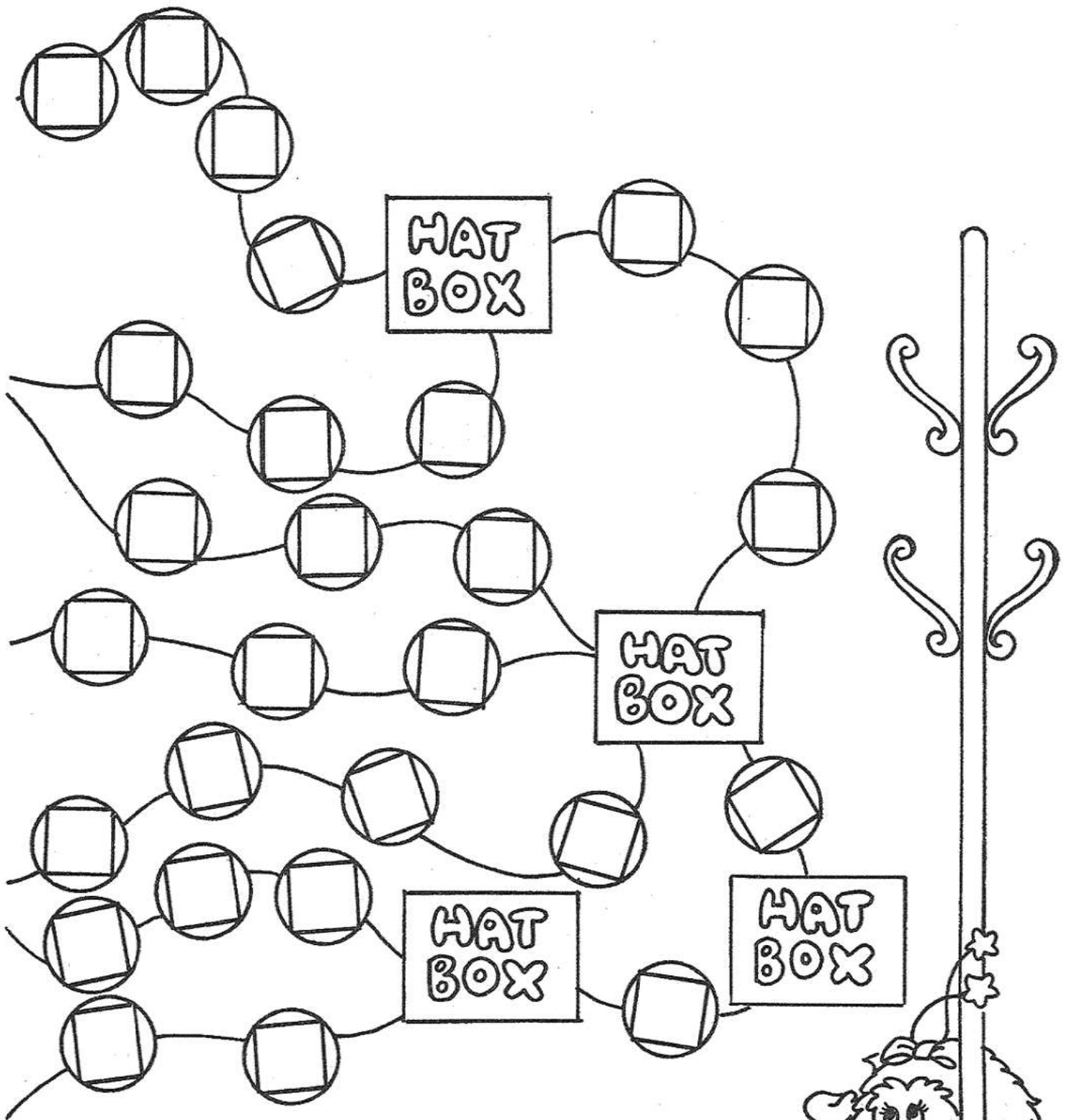

3. Find the START box and put a button here.

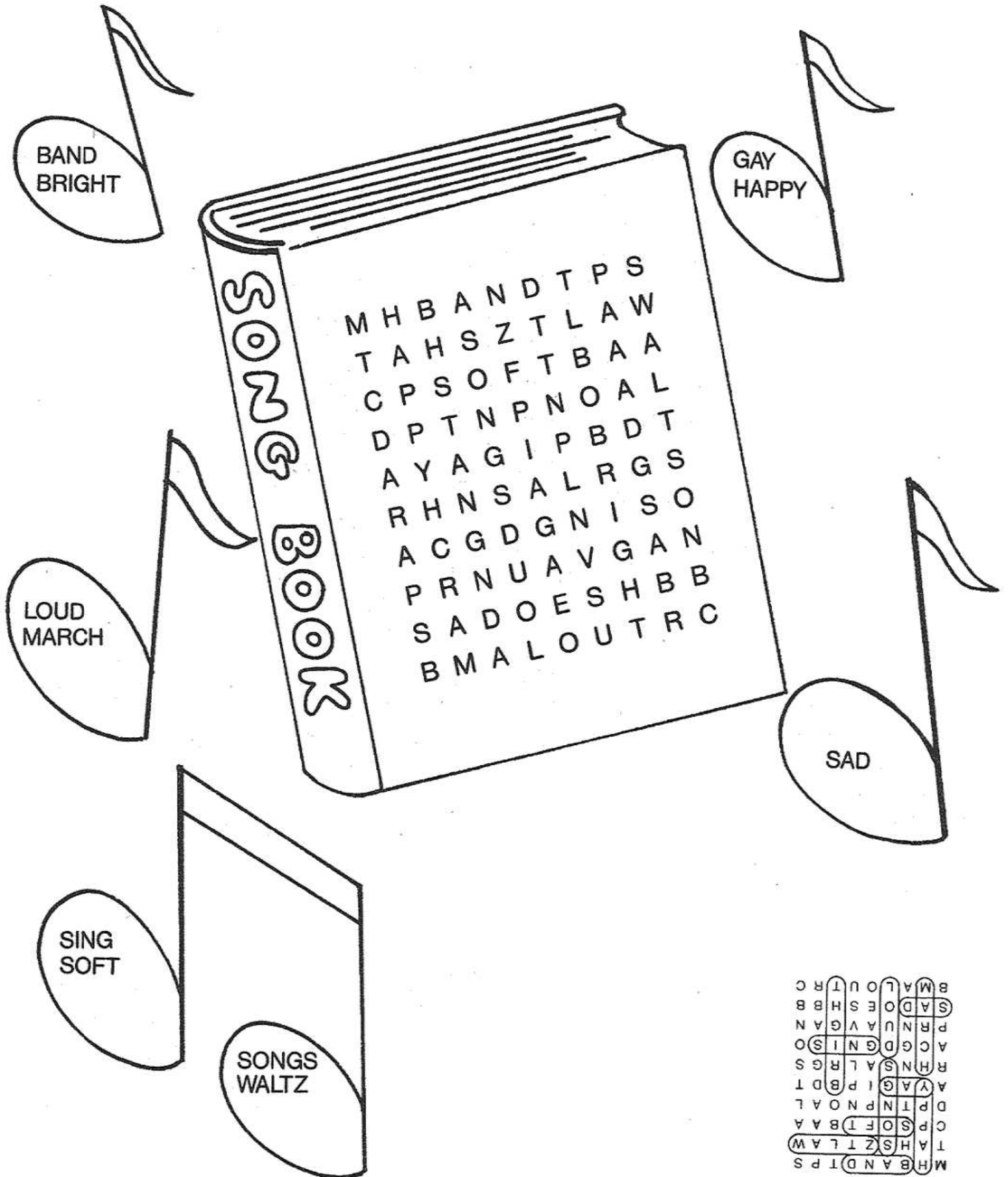


4. When it's your turn, move the button four moves in any direction. If you land on a hat box or pass over one, pick up the card that's there and put it on your hat rack. If it's a card you already have or a "no hat" card, put it back on the hat box without letting the other player see it.
5. If you land on or pass over the other player's button, take a hat from that player's hat rack. He or she must then go back to START. The player to fill the hat rack first is the winner.

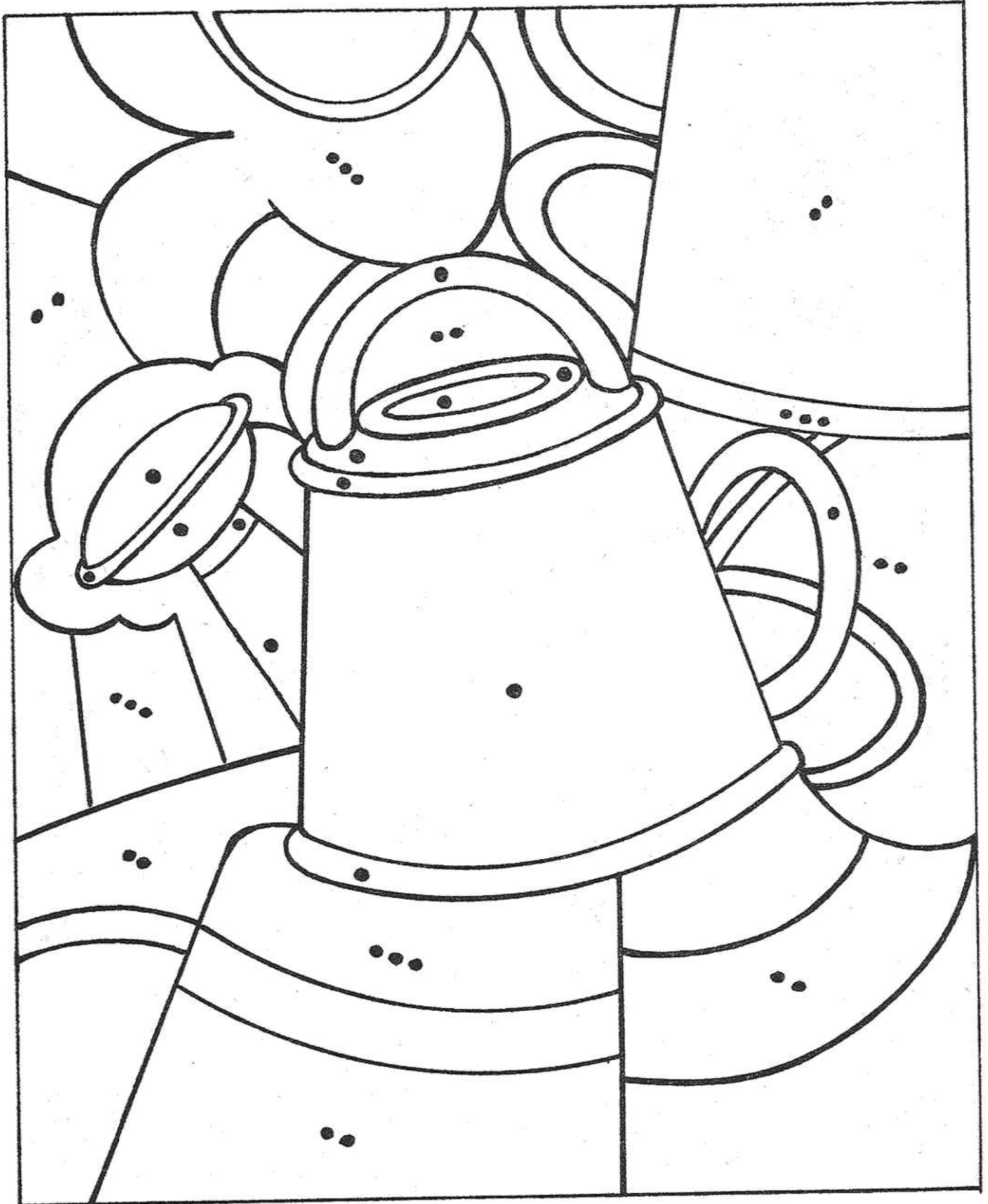


Star-Stepping Sprite

This little Sprite would like to reach the big STAR in the far corner of the heavens. Can you show her the shortest way, where she will step past only ten stars?



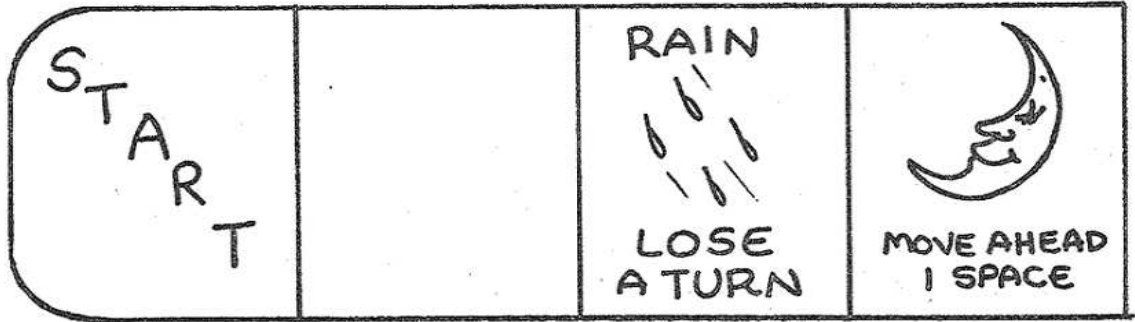

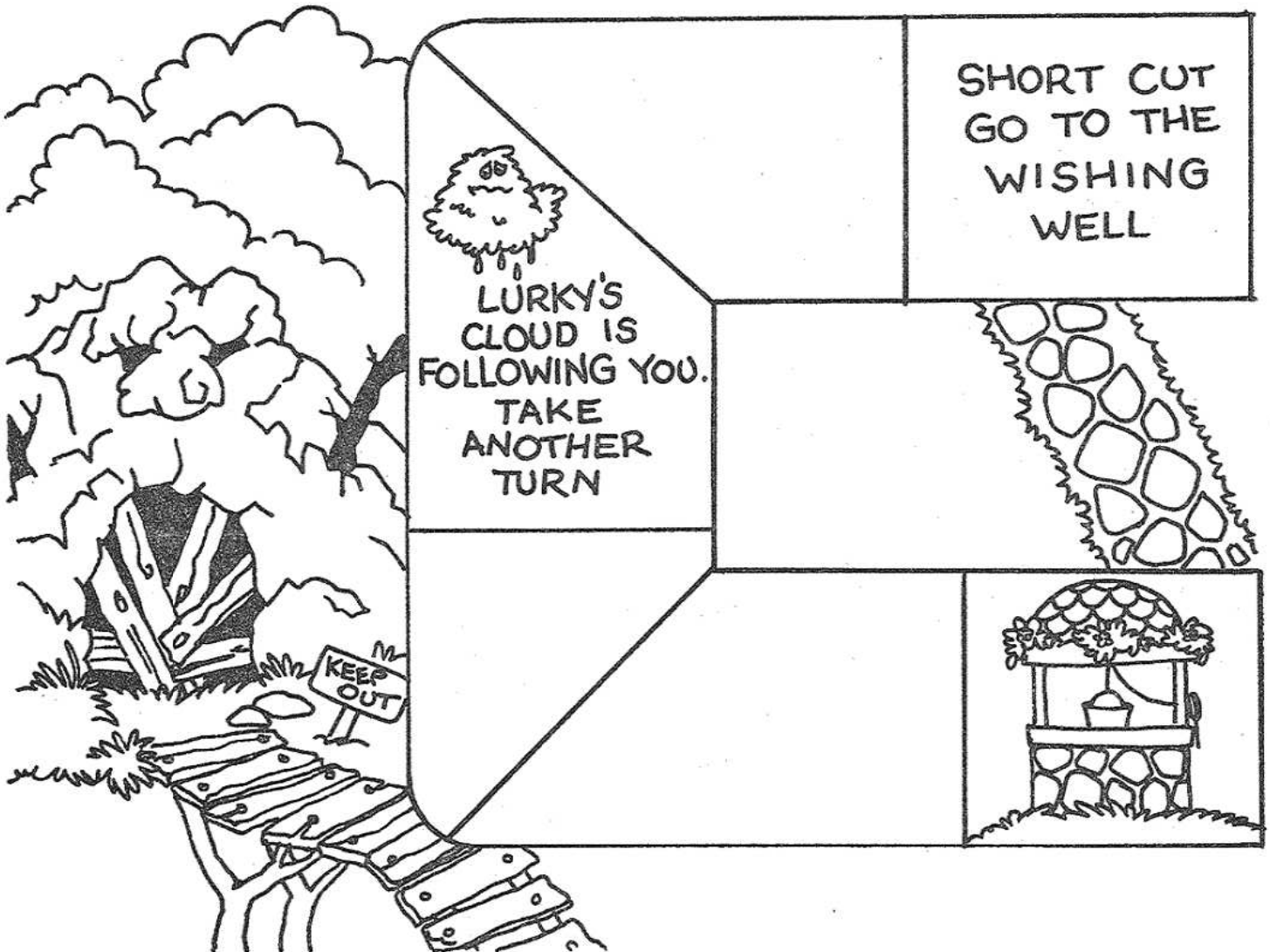


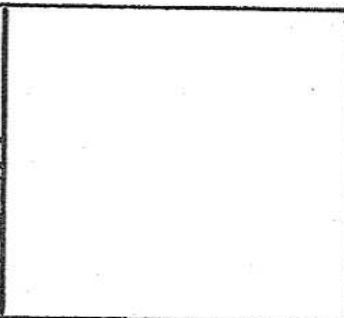
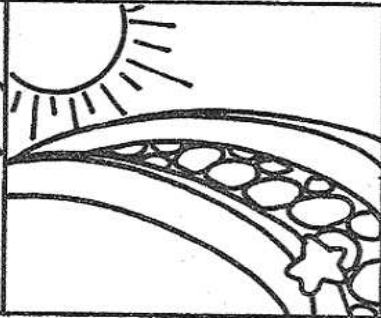
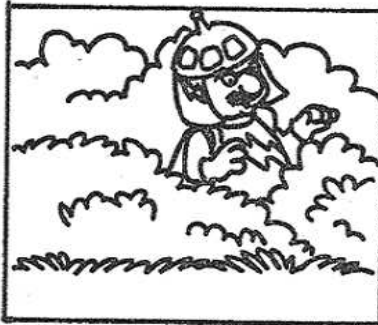
DOME SWEET DOME
